15. P allows his agent to purchase goods for him on credit from T, and pays for them. On one occasion he pays his agent to purchase the goods. The agent misappropriate the money and purchased goods on credit from T. Whether T can recover the price of the goods from P? Decide.
16. A bought a horse from B. A wanted to enter the horse in a race. A did not inform the same to B. Turns out the horse was not capable of running a race on account of being lame – Can B be made liable for defect? Decide.
